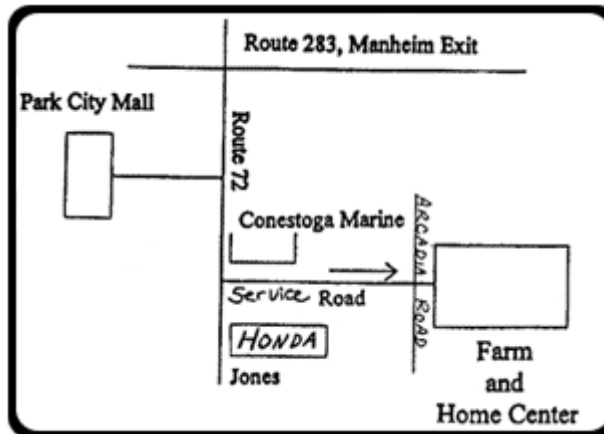

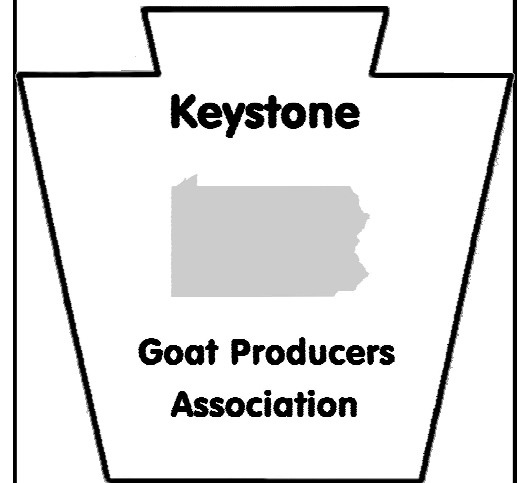
Rt 30 East to Rt 72 (1st Exit Past Park city)
